

Victims of Domestic Abuse/Violence

MARCH 2016

Safe Horizon

For the launch of two satellite mental health clinics for survivors of domestic violence, one at a shelter and one at a community program (\$50,000).

JUNE 2016

Philadelphia Children's Alliance

Towards the salary of a full-time therapist for children traumatized by sexual abuse (\$120,000 over two years).

NOVEMBER 2016

New Destiny Housing Corporation

For a consultant to deliver training in trauma-informed case management and counseling for staff at four supportive housing facilities serving previously homeless domestic violence survivors in New York City (\$100,000 over two years).

APRIL 2017

Laurel House

To expand the organization's Professional Counseling program that annually assists some 230 domestic violence victims and survivors with more than 1,100 counseling hours (\$30,000 over two years).

Safe Center LI

Support for an additional part-time children's counselor in their Children's Mental Health Program, which provides trauma-informed mental health services to child victims of domestic violence, teen dating violence, sexual abuse, commercial sexual exploitation and trafficking (\$50,000 over two years).

Sakhi for South Asian Women

For support to hire a bilingual, part-time licensed clinical counselor for South Asian immigrant women overcoming domestic violence, and for the costs of an upcoming Executive Director transition (\$25,000).

NOVEMBER 2017

Womankind (FORMERLY NEW YORK ASIAN WOMEN'S CENTER)

Support to allow a "Lead Program Counselor" position to become full-time and provide more creative, trauma-informed care to Asian families who have experienced gender-based violence (\$80,000 over two years).
